



Marching Band Uniform Guidelines and Contract

Each member of the Lodi High School Marching Band, and his/her/their parents/guardians, agree to be responsible for all the items listed in the table below which have been issued to the student.

The parent/guardian and student are responsible for the upkeep of all uniform components during the marching band season. **These uniforms are DRY CLEAN ONLY; they must not be laundered at home.** If your student soils, stains or dirties the uniform prior to the end of the season, please contact our uniform coordinator right away to arrange for cleaning, and an additional \$10 cleaning fee will be assessed.

The Boosters ensure that all uniforms are dry-cleaned at the end of each season and assesses any damages during inventory to have repaired prior to the next season.

No food or drinks (except water) may be consumed while in uniform!

Uniforms will be stored in the annex and/or band trailer at LHS in between performances; they are not to be taken home without authorization from the band director.

Uniform pants (bibs) will be hemmed prior to distribution at no charge to the student(s). The hem of the pants should hit the TOP of the shoe; pants should not drag on the ground. Pants that are too long will become ripped and frayed at the hem. **If a bib is returned with hem damage you will be charged for a new replacement bib.** Do not cut any fabric! Please report any uniform issues to our uniform coordinator.

Students will be issued one pair of gloves at the beginning of the season. If the student misplaces their gloves he/she/they must purchase another pair for \$3 from our uniform coordinator.

Students will need to purchase BLACK Drillmaster field marching shoes from www.bandshoppe.com. These should be ordered within the first two weeks of the of the new school year.

Socks must be solid black and calf length. It is highly recommended that students pack an extra pair of black socks in their garment bag.

Makeup should be minimal.

Jewelry should be minimal. Only simple plain stud earrings are permitted. Large earrings and piercings must be removed while in uniform.

The parent/guardian and student further agree to return the entire uniform in good condition at the end of the marching band season or upon the request of the band director or principal.

Please note that students must turn in complete uniforms at the designated time. Report cards, schedules, transcripts and/or diplomas will be held until the uniform is returned or replacement fees are paid.
